Foliage:	Mid green foliage.	
Habit:	Tidy, small-medium, clumping habit 16" x 16"; flower stem 24".	
Propagation:	Tip cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>	
Culture:	Easy care - grow in well drained soil in full sun; drought tolerant once established.	
Additional Comments:	Tolerant of heat & humidity.	
Uses:	Perennial Border, Large Pots & Containers.	

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	8-12 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring planting).
6" - Gallons:	12-16 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring planting).
