Digitalis Goldcrest ('Waldigone')

Key Features

- ✓ Unique apricot to peach blooms.
- ✓ Sterile blooms giving an exceptionally long flowering period.
- ✓ Great for early season promotions.

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Digitalis grandiflora x obscura</i>
Protection Status:	USPP 20937; COFP Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
Bloom:	Sterile uniquely colored peach to apricot blooms with peach to red blush.
Bloom Period:	Early summer - fall. (Long flowering season).
Foliage:	Deep green semi-evergreen foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 18" x 12".
Propagation:	Tissue Culture / Division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun to part shade, in fertile well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Trim hard back in spring to encourage strong new basal growth.
Uses:	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.



Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	4-6 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
6" - Gallons:	8-10 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).

Closest Variety: *D. 'Spice Island'* (PP17,849) **Key Differences:** ✓ **Goldcrest** peach-apricot blooms **vs.** pale lemon-peach blooms.
 ✓ **Goldcrest** early season bloom **vs.** medium season bloom.
 ✓ **Goldcrest** short **vs.** short-medium.
