Heuchera 'Crimson Curls'

Key Features

- ✓ Distinctive crisp curly plum colored foliage.
- ✓ Great garden performance.
- ✓ Good sun tolerance.

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	Heuchera <i>hybrid</i>
Protection Status:	PP13,729; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 3. (-40°F or -39°C).
Bloom:	Sprays of small bell shaped white blooms on burgundy stems.
Bloom Period:	Mid summer.
Foliage:	Crisp curly plum colored foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 18" x 20".
Propagation:	Tissue Culture / Divisions / Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun – partial shade, moist well fertilized soil.
Additional Comments:	Exhibits good sun tolerance. Top dress with slow release fertilizer in early spring.
Uses:	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.



Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	6-8 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (spring planting).
6" - Gallons:	8-12 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (spring planting).

Closest Variety: H. 'Palace Purple' **Key Differences:** ✓ 'Crimson Curls' crisp curly foliage **vs.** flat foliage.
 ✓ 'Crimson Curls' good sun tolerance **vs.** best if shade.
 ✓ 'Crimson Curls' great garden performance **vs.** average performance.
