## Salvia 'Ultra Violet'

### Key Features

- ✓ Showy iridescent mauve-purple blooms.
- ✓ Compact tidy grower.
- ✓ Easy care, drought tolerant once established.



### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Salvia hybrida</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PPAF; COPF Open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 5b. (-15°F or -26°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Sprays of showy iridescent mauve-purple blooms.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Summer – fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Mid green aromatic foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact rounded habit 24" x 24".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun, well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Quick growing. Drought tolerant once established. Browse resistant – deer and rabbit.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, Borders, Landscape Planting.

### Approximate Finishing Time

<b>4.5"- Quarts:</b>	<b>4-6 weeks</b> from a 128 plug (spring planting).
<b>6" - Gallons:</b>	<b>8-10 weeks</b> from a 128 plug (spring planting).

**Closest Variety:** *S. greggii*

**Key Differences:**

- ✓ 'Ultra Violet' compact habit **vs.** medium-large habit.
- ✓ 'Ultra Violet' mid foliage **vs.** gray/green foliage.
- ✓ 'Ultra Violet' iridescent blooms **vs.** blooms red through white.
