Sedum 'Elsie's Gold'

Key Features

- ✓ Large flat heads of small star shaped soft shell pink aging to deep magenta blooms.
- ✓ Long summer – fall blooming period.
- ✓ Drought tolerant once established.

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Sedum spectabile</i>
Protection Status:	PPAF; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 3-9. (40°F or -40°C).
Bloom:	Soft shell pink aging to deep magenta.
Bloom Period:	Summer – fall.
Foliage:	Large toothed foliage with warm golden yellow leaf margins, fading to a soft creamy white by fall.
Habit:	Compact clump forming habit 12" x 12".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Attracts bees and butterflies. Dried flower heads are excellent for winter garden accents.
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Landscape Planting, Cut Flower.



Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	6-8 weeks from a 72 plug (spring planting).
6" - Gallons:	10-12 weeks from a 72 plug (spring planting).

Closest Variety: S. Autumn Charm ('Lajos') PP14,421	Key Differences: ✓ 'Elsie's Gold' less reversion vs. more reversion. ✓ 'Elsie's Gold' more vigor vs. less vigor. ✓ 'Elsie's Gold' shell pink blooms vs. shell pink blooms.
