Solidago Little Lemon ('Dansolitem')

Key Features

- ✓ Unique light-yellow blooms.
- ✓ Tight compact habit.
- ✓ Drought tolerant once established.



Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Solidago hybrida</i>
Protection Status:	PP17,297; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Dense inflorescence of light-yellow blooms.
Bloom Period:	Summer – fall.
Foliage:	Medium green foliage.
Habit:	Compact clump forming habit 12" x 12".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Landscape Planting, Cut Flower.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	6-8 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).
6" - Gallons:	8-12 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).

Closest Variety: S. 'Gold Rush'

Key Differences: ✓ **Little Lemon** compact habit **vs.** compact-medium habit.
 ✓ **Little Lemon** light lemon yellow blooms **vs.** yellow blooms.
 ✓ **Little Lemon** well branched **vs.** average.
