Veronica Royal Candles (*Glory*)

Key Features

- ✓ Abundant spires of deep violet blue blooms.
- ✓ Tight compact habit.
- ✓ Bottom foliage does not die out unlike other selections.



Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Veronica spicata</i>
Protection Status:	PP18,932; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 3. (-40°F or -40°C).
Bloom:	Abundant spires of deep violet blue blooms.
Bloom Period:	Summer.
Foliage:	Deep green foliage. Bottom foliage does not die out unlike other selections.
Habit:	Tight compact clump forming habit 18" x 18".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun to partial shade, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

- 4.5" - Quarts: 6-8 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).
6" - Gallons: 8-12 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).

Closest Variety: *S. 'Sunny Border Blue'* **Key Differences:** ✓ **'Royal Candles'** compact habit **vs.** medium habit.
 ✓ **'Royal Candles'** deep violet blue blooms **vs.** violet blue.
 ✓ **'Royal Candles'** bottom foliage does not die **vs.** regular die back.
